Below is a list of our requirements/points to note for the night of the show. The list ensures the safety of the audience and the band, and that the quality of the show is unaffected. You may need to confirm some of these points with the venue to make sure they can be arranged. If you cannot meet any of the requirements please contact us to discuss further.

- A minimum of 4, 13 amp sockets on-stage for band equipment and lighting
- A minimum of 2, 13 amp sockets off-stage for sound technician
- A raised stage area if possible. If a stage can't be provided the performance area must be clearly defined
- A performance area of no less than 15 feet wide by 10 feet deep
- A secure, private and adequately equipped changing and rest area located immediately next to or immediately behind the performance area, to allow for between-set and mid-set costume changes
- Unlimited soft drinks and limited snacks on the day of the performance
- An uninterrupted setting-up and preparation time before first performance of 2.5 hours
- Band can take down equipment and remove equipment from the room without affecting enjoyment or safety of the remaining guests
- An orderly venue with a safe and secure environment for us to perform our duties
- We reserve the right to cease our performance without notice upon uninvited interruption onto the stage by anyone during the performance
- No unauthorised access to the performance area, or use of the band's equipment at any time during the night
- Adequate public liability cover by the venue
- If you require background music, or use of our pa for public address (for example presentations/speeches) we may be able to assist, but please advise us of your requirements in good time. Please note that background music is not a dj service - ie songs won't be mixed or introduced. Music will stop at 11.45pm
- Vehicular access to directly outside the building's entry/exit doors
- Unfortunately, due to their negative effect on the performance, we do not play at venues with a sound meter set at less than 120 decibels
